

HONORS/MERIT DISTINCTION

The Academy would like to acknowledge and congratulate all of our student-athletes that achieved honors in the second term and those students who received the merit award for extra effort. In the second term, 22 of our student-athletes achieved honors or merit distinction for their academic achievement. Currently, 44% of Hockey Academy students are achieving honors or merit distinction compared to 32% in the first term. In addition, ten student-athletes in elementary were nominated for merit distinction by their teachers which represents an increase of 2 students as compared to the first term.
